CEMETERIES IN NICHOL, PILKINGTON AND PEEL

TOWNSHIPS

As we visited the different cemeteries in Nichol, Pilkington and Peel Townships, we were surprised to find that the early settlers had come to this area from the British Isles in the early 1800's. In most cases, none of their families remain here, hence the reason for the neglect we found.

However, it seems to me, that is ample reason for us to honour these pioneers whose remains are resting here.

We found some of the older stones, broken, and of a softer marble and hard to decipher the markings. Some had favourite bible verses; also years, months, days; others had less detail.

We learned that Provincial Registration of births, deaths and marriages did not begin until 1869. So church records, family Bibles and the tombstones are searched for accurate information. People are searching for roots and a sense of belonging and in that way we trust this survey may be of value.

THE BON ACCORD AREA

Scotch settlers came by way of Fergus to the Bon Accord area (part of Nichol Township). They built a church and school and later this church was abandoned. A new church was built in Elora. The old cemetery remains and the cairn was built honouring the pioneers 1837 - 1937.
